Aims and Scope

The **BAJC Conference 2018** - the 6th Annual Conference of Baosteel-Australia Joint Research and Development Centre (BAJC) will be held in University of Wollongong (*detailed venue will be advised*) on **Monday February 5, 2018**.

This conference aims to enhance communication and collaboration among the researchers from participating institutions working in the areas of particular significance for Baosteel's middle- and long- term strategic development. The conference will provide opportunities for the BAJC project participants to present and discuss research activities. It will also provide an opportunity for participating institutions and their researchers to explore their innovation ideas and demonstrate their capacities to Baosteel.

All project participants, particularly the Research Fellows and RHD students who are involved in BAJC projects, are encouraged to attend the conference. Lead CIs or his/her representatives of each project team are required to present key outcomes and findings at the conference. Research Fellows and PhD/Master students who plan to attend the BAJC Conference should provide a two-page extended abstract or short paper which may use graphs, to show results for a presentation at the conference.

The extended abstract or short paper should be prepared in the format of a template which will be distributed separately. All abstracts will be included as conference proceedings of BAJC Conference 2018.

BAJC Conference 2018 is continuously focusing on the three themes as follows:

1. Iron- and steel-making processes and steel materials;
2. Light metals (titanium, magnesium, aluminium); and
3. Energy storage materials, e.g. key materials for high energy density batteries and super-capacitors

Registration

The Conference is open to researchers from participating institutions only. All participants are required to register to attend BAJC Conference 2018.

Early bird registrations, received before **Monday January 15, 2018**, will be paid by BAJC (*conditions apply**). Registrations received after the early bird date, a fee of \$200 will be applied.
