The BAJC Baosteel Funding 2023 Call for Applications

Background

The Baosteel-Australia Joint Research and Development Centre (BAJC) is a joint venture between Baosteel - one of the world's largest steel companies, and five Australian universities - The University of Queensland, The University of New South Wales, Monash University and University of Wollongong and Deakin Universality. Baosteel provides funding for BAJC to conduct joint industrial technology research, aiming to develop innovative technologies in areas of interest to Baosteel and aligned with the research capacities of the participant universities.

Baosteel will provide funding support up to \$2,000,000 for research projects through BAJC in 2023. The funding is now open for applications. The selected projects will commence on 1 January 2023. The successful projects will receive maximum grant of up to AUD \$150,000 per year for a maximum duration of three years.

Application Process

The Baosteel funding application follows a two-stage process - Expression of Interest (EOI) and Full Proposal. The EOI succinctly outlining the project proposal is invited to be submitted to BAJC in the prescribed EOI Template to admin@bajc.org.au by due date. After evaluation by BAJC Advisory Technical Panel and the selection committee of Baosteel, the highly ranked EOIs will be invited to submit full proposals for further evaluation process.

Due Date

Cal for EOI: Fridday 24 March 2023

Closing EOI: Monday 8 May 2023

Invited Full Proposal: Early June 2023 (approximately)

Outcome Announcement: Mid-August or early September 2023 (approximately)
