Aims and Scope

The BAJC Conference 2024 of Baosteel-Australia Joint Research and Development Centre (BAJC) will be held in scenic **Hunter Valley, New South Wales, on Monday 26th February 2024.**

BAJC Conference is a key event of the Centre. It fosters communication and collaboration among the researchers from participating institutions. The conference brings together the researchers who are from BAJC participating institutions and working in the areas of interest to Baosteel to establish and further develop collaboration with Baosteel by exchanging information on their latest research. It does not only provide a platform for the BAJC project participants to present and discuss research activities, but also provide an opportunity for all participating institutions and their researchers to explore their innovation ideas and present their capacities to Baosteel. This paves the way for potential new research ventures, ripe for Baosteel grants via BAJC.

All project participants, particularly the Research Fellows and RHD students who are involved in BAJC projects directly and indirectly, currently, and previously, are encouraged to attend the conference. The BAJC Conference 2024 will be held in scenic Hunter Valley, New South Wales. BAJC research teams are expected to present their research work or innovative ideas for future BAJC project development. The attendees are encouraged to provide a two-page extended abstract or short paper which may use graphs/tables/equations for presentation at the conference.

The extended abstract or short paper should be prepared in the format of a template provided by BAJC. All accepted abstracts/short papers will be included in the Abstracts Book of BAJC Conference 2024.

BAJC Conference 2024 focuses on the four research themes as below:

- Advanced iron- and steel-making processes and steel materials.
- Design and processing technologies for light metals (Al, Ti, Mg).
- Digital and smart controlling and optimizing technologies for steel industry.
- Decarbonisation and low-CO₂ emission technologies for iron and steel making.
- Energy-saving and environment-friendly technologies for steel production

Registration

The Conference is mainly open to researchers from BAJC participating institutions. All participants to attend BAJC Conference 2024 are required to register. The registration to the conference is free, more information as follows.
